ORDINANCE NO. 22-012

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING AND SMOKE AND DYE TESTING SERVICES FOR THE SANITARY SEWER OVERFLOW REMEDIATION PROGRAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WADSWORTH, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Service is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement for professional engineering and smoke and dye testing services for the Sanitary Sewer Overflow (SSO) Remediation Program. The payment obligation pursuant to said agreement shall not exceed \$170,000.

Section 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were passed in an open meeting of this council, and that all deliberations of this council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety in the City of Wadsworth in order to expedite the analysis and identification of stormwater connections/sources to the sanitary sewer system for the SSO Remediation Program; WHEREFORE, this ordinance shall go into immediate effect provided that it receives a two thirds vote of all members of city council. If it receives approval by a majority of the members but less than a two-thirds vote, then it shall be effective at the earliest time permitted by law.
