AN ORDINANCE TO MAKE A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION OF \$60,855.00 IN THE 440 ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT FUND FOR PURPOSES OTHER THAN PERSONAL SERVICES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2022

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WADSWORTH, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That this Council hereby authorizes the Auditor of the City of Wadsworth to increase the appropriations for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2022 by the following amount:

Section 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety in the City of Wadsworth in order to make funds available to obtain land for the City of Wadsworth; WHEREFORE, this ordinance shall go into immediate effect upon receipt of the county auditor’s certificate required for this appropriation pursuant to section 5705.39 of the Ohio Revised Code provided it receives a two-thirds vote of all members of City Council. If it receives approval by a majority of the members but less than a two-thirds vote, then it shall be effective at the earliest time permitted by law.
