AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY TO DONATE 13 WATCHGUARD VISTA BODY-WORN CAMERAS, 2 WATCHGUARD VISTA TRANSFER STATIONS AND ASSORTED WATCHGUARD VISTA PARTS/ACCESSORIES TO THE MONTVILLE TOWNSHIP TRUSTEES FOR USE BY THE MONTVILLE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WADSWORTH, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That this Council hereby determines the following items: 13 Watchguard VISTA body-worn cameras, 2 Watchguard VISTA Transfer Stations and assorted Watchguard VISTA parts/accessories are no longer needed by the Wadsworth Police Department.

Section 2. That this Council hereby authorizes the Director of Public Safety to donate the following items: 13 Watchguard VISTA body-worn cameras, 2 Watchguard VISTA Transfer Stations and assorted Watchguard VISTA parts/accessories to the Montville Township Trustees for use by the Montville Police Department.

Section 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety in the City of Wadsworth in order to avoid having to continue to store obsolete and no longer needed items; WHEREFORE, this ordinance shall go into immediate effect provided that it receives a two thirds vote of all members of city council. If it receives approval of a majority of the members but less than a two-thirds vote, then it shall be effective at the earliest time permitted by law.
