AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 21-034 TO CORRECT THE NEW WADSWORTH CITY LOT NUMBER TO 10166 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, this Council on June 1, 2021 approved by Ordinance No. 21-034 creating New Wadsworth City Lot Number of 10164, and

WHEREAS, the City's Building and Planning Department was informed that the correct Wadsworth City Lot Number is 10166, WHEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WADSWORTH, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That this Council hereby amends Ordinance No. 21-034 to reflect the correct Wadsworth City Lot Number as 10166.

Section 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety in the City of Wadsworth to promote economic development; WHEREFORE, this ordinance shall go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds vote of all members of City Council. If it receives approval by a majority of the members but less than a two-thirds vote, then it shall be effective at the earliest time permitted by law.
