**AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE DRAWING OF A WARRANT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$12,983.13 FOR THE PAYMENT OF THE AMOUNT DUE UPON A CONTRACT WITH QUALITY CONTROL INSPECTION, INC. AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, a contract was entered into by an officer or employee of the City of Wadsworth with Quality Control Inspection, Inc., without an attached certificate of the fiscal officer of the City of Wadsworth as required by section 5705.41(D)(1) of the Ohio Revised Code, and

**WHEREAS**, the Auditor of the City of Wadsworth (the fiscal officer) has presented to the Council of the City of Wadsworth a certificate that there was at the time of the making of the aforesaid contract and at the time of the execution of such certificate, a sufficient sum appropriated for the purpose of such contract and in the treasury or in the process of collection to the appropriated funds free from any previous encumbrances, and that the expenditures will be valid if authorized by the city council as the taxing authority within thirty days from the receipt of the certificate, and

**WHEREAS**, this Council finds that payment should be authorized as to this contract, **NOW THEREFORE**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WADSWORTH, STATE OF OHIO:**

**Section 1.** That pursuant to section 5704.41(D)(1) of the Ohio Revised Code, this Council, based on the certificate received from the Auditor of the City of Wadsworth (the fiscal officer) does hereby authorize the drawing of warrant in payment of an amount not to exceed \$12,983.13 due upon the contract with Quality Control Inspection, Inc. entered into without an attached certificate of the fiscal officer of the City of Wadsworth.

**Section 2.** That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety in the City of Wadsworth in order to pay without undue delay for services and products received by the City of Wadsworth; **WHEREFORE**, this ordinance shall go into immediate effect.

**AN ORDINANCE GIVING CONSENT TO THE OHIO DIRECTOR OF TRANSPORTATION TO PERFORM A BRIDGE REPLACEMENT LOCATED 1,200 FEET SOUTH OF THE SEVILLE ROAD INTERSECTION ON STATE ROUTE 57 AT SLM 1.36 OVER BLOCKERS CREEK IN THE CITY OF WADSWORTH IN MEDINA COUNTY, TO COOPERATE WITH THE OHIO DIRECTOR OF TRANSPORTATION IN REGARD TO THE PORTION OF THE PROJECT WITHIN THE WADSWORTH CORPORATION LIMIT, AGREEING TO PROVIDE ADEQUATE MAINTENANCE UPON COMPLETION, AGREEING TO BE REIMBURSE FOR ALL UTILITY ACCOMMODATIONS AND RELOCATIONS AS RELATED TO SAID PROJECT AND AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE OHIO DIRECTOR OF TRANSPORTATION AGREEING TO THE AFORESAID TERMS FOR SAID PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WADSWORTH, STATE OF OHIO:**

**Section 1.** That this Council finds it to be in the public interest to consent and does give consent to the Ohio Director of Transportation (ODOT) to complete the above described project.

**Section 2.** That this Council agrees that the City of Wadsworth shall cooperate with the Ohio Director of Transportation (ODOT), for the portion of the above described project within the Wadsworth Corporation Limit, as follows:

1. ODOT agrees to assume and bear one hundred percent (100%) of the project costs.
2. The City of Wadsworth will be responsible for one hundred percent (100%) of the total cost for added construction items requested by the City and not necessary for the improvement as determined by the State and the Federal Highway Administration;

**Section 3.** That upon completion of the described Project, and otherwise agreed, the City of Wadsworth shall:

1. Provide adequate maintenance for the described project in accordance with all applicable state and federal laws;
2. Provide ample financial provisions, as necessary, for the maintenance of the described project.

**Section 4.** That this Council agrees if City owned utilities, within a corporation limit or in a private easement outside corporation limits, which need to be relocated due to this ODOT project, the City will be reimbursed for any relocation work; ODOT will perform the

coordination, relocation, and reimbursement which shall comply with current provisions of 23 CFR 645 and the ODOT Utilities Manual.

If other public and private utilities need to be relocated due to this ODOT project they will not be reimbursed for relocation; with exceptions due to an easement, etc.

**Section 5.** That the Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the Ohio Director of Transportation agreeing to the terms as set forth in this ordinance.

**Section 6.** That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety in the City of Wadsworth in order to promote highway safety; WHEREFORE, this ordinance shall go into immediate effect provided that it receives a two thirds vote of all members of city council. If it receives approval by a majority of the members but less than a two-thirds vote, then it shall be effective at the earliest time permitted by law.
