



## ***Initiatives & Services***

### **OhioMHAS STATE GRANTS and OPIATE INITIATIVES**

#### **Addiction Treatment Program (ATP) Grant**

- Provides funding for ancillary services for individuals with a substance use diagnosis that are served by the Judge who oversees the Specialized Docket programs through Medina Common Pleas Adult and Juvenile Courts, and Medina Municipal Court's Valor (Veterans) Court.

#### **Alcohol Use Disorder (AUD) Funding**

- Grant funding to expand treatment and recovery support services for persons with alcohol use/misuse disorder.

#### **Community Transition Program (CTP)**

- Grant funding to OhioGuidestone to provide community linkage for offenders with serious mental illness and/or substance use.

#### **Criminal Justice and Behavioral Health (CJBH) Linkage Grant**

- Provides funding for linkage services for individuals incarcerated at the Medina County Jail and Juvenile Detention Center.
- Assists with linking individuals to follow up treatment, medication and psychiatric services to prevent recidivism.

#### **Jail Psychotropic Medication Assistance**

- Received a grant to assist with the cost of psychotropic drugs dispensed in the Medina County Jail.

#### **Medina County Health Department**

- Narcan Kits available to the public through Health Department's Project DAWN Clinic.

## **Medina County Opiate Response Team (MCORT)**

- Grant funding to Alternative Paths for the Medina County Opiate Response Team, which was formed in partnership with the Medina County Sheriff's Department.

## **Opiate Task Force**

- Created an Opiate Task Force in partnership with the Medina County Health Department.

## **Specialized Dockets**

- Pass through funding for the operation of the certified adult and juvenile drug court programs, the certified adult mental health court, the certified Recovery court, and Valor (Veteran's) court.

## **State Opioid Response (SOR)**

- Recovery peer support specialists from Hope Recovery Community in the Medina County Jail and on the 24/7 Crisis & Behavioral Health Helpline, in partnership with Alternative Paths.
- Hope Recovery Community's Hope Link Support Program to provide temporary linkage services when people are waiting for connection to permanent services.
- Hope Recovery Community's Hope on the Move Program to reduce transportation barriers to individuals impacted by substance use.
- Support for Hope Recovery Community to provide peer recovery support and programming at the Brown-Trump farm property.
- Medina County Family Support Program, a collaboration between Hope Recovery Community and Robby's Voice to provide family peer support programming to those who have a family member struggling with addiction.
- Two Recovery Services Navigators through OhioGuidestone to provide a single point of contact and facilitate linkage for those seeking treatment services, peer recovery, or recovery supports.
- Development of Hope Kits, a prevention and education tool through Hope Recovery Community that provides literature, county-wide resources, stigma-busting messages, peer link info, and more.
- Expansion of Intensive Outpatient Programming at OhioGuidestone.
- Operational support for the Discovery Recovery House, a Level 3 women's recovery house owned by the MHRB and managed by OhioGuidestone.
- Operational support for Cathy's House, Level 1 and Level 2 men's recovery houses, and the Level 1 recovery farm house at the Brown-Trump property.

- Resources for withdrawal management & residential services for individuals to access higher levels of care through Alternative Paths, the MHRB's gatekeeper.
- Cathy's House Resident Coordinator through Hope Recovery Community to assist residents with their recovery plan, including monitoring of their Medication Assisted Treatment Plan, and assuring that medications are taken as prescribed.

## **YOUTH AND SCHOOL INITIATIVES**

### **Whole Child Matters Initiative**

- Funding to OhioGuidestone to provide Early Childhood Mental Health services to Medina County preschools.

### **The Children's Center of Medina County**

- Provided one-time funding to The Children's Center capital project to assist the center with continuing to nurture abused and neglected children through collaboration, advocacy, treatment and prevention.
- Provide funding to The Children's Center for crisis intervention and mental health services.

### **Hope Squad**

- Peer/student led suicide prevention program.

### **K-12 Prevention Initiative**

- Individualized evidence-based prevention programming for local school districts; leading to the implementation and expansion of initiatives such as Hope Squad, 7 Mindsets, ROX, Skillstreaming, Teen Mental Health First Aid, and Second Step programming.

### **Medina County Juvenile Drug Court Program**

- Funding through Alternative Paths to support the substance use and mental health treatment of teens involved with Medina Juvenile Court.

### **Mental Health First Aid**

- The Medina County MHRB collaborated with Kent State University to bring this program to all seven Medina County School Districts.

### **OhioSTART (Sobriety, Treatment and Reducing Trauma)**

- An intervention program that provides intensive trauma counseling to children who have suffered victimization due to substance use by a parent, as well as peer support

to families with the overall goal of stabilizing families so that children and parents can recover and lead substance use-free lives.

### **Prevention Services**

- Funding through contracted agencies to provide school and community-wide prevention services.

### **SHARE (Student Health, Advocacy, Resources and Empowerment)**

- Provide funding for youth leadership events, such as Red Ribbon Week, Middle School Leadership, and educational workshops.

### **Student Drug Testing Kits**

- Medina City Schools and Wadsworth City Schools.

### **Youth Service Coordination**

- Assistance with services for high risk, multi-system youth with serious mental health issues who have been unsuccessful in traditional forms of local treatment.

## **COMMUNITY**

### **Community Assessment & Treatment Services (CATS)**

- The MHRB provided funding for start-up expenses at CATS' residential treatment center.

### **Crisis Services**

- Caring Contact Collaboration contract between Akron Children's Hospital and Alternative Paths to serve high risk youth.

### **Highland House**

- The MHRB owns the Highland House, which is the home of Hope Recovery Community (HRC) who provides peer support and recovery support services.
- The house was purchased and renovated by the MHRB in FY2019, in combination with OhioMHAS capital grant funding. In FY2022, the MHRB obtained capital grant funding to expand the facility to 7,000 square feet.

### **Hope Recovery Community (HRC)**

- The MHRB purchased and renovated the house at 200 Highland Drive in the city of Medina, for Hope Recovery Community to run a Recovery Community Organization (RCO) that provides peer recovery services and a wide array of recovery supports.

- The MHRB provides funding for peer recovery services.
- Provided funding for HRC to open a satellite facility in the city of Brunswick, and supported their efforts to expand programming into Wadsworth.

### **Medina County Adult Interdisciplinary Team (I-Team)**

- A collaboration involving a team of professionals that assist with planning services for vulnerable adults who are abused, neglected, or exploited.

### **Medina County Jail Services**

- Funding to Alternative Paths to provide clinical services within the jail.
- Funding for treatment driven drug testing at the jail.
- Assistance with funding reimbursement from OhioMHAS for psychotropic medications dispensed at the jail.

### **Medina County Common Pleas Courts**

- Funding to Alternative Paths for Forensic Monitoring and Case Management services for Specialized Docket Mental Health Court participants engaged with Medina Common Pleas Court.
- Mental Health Court Program (MHCP) funding provided through the MHRB.
- Funding provided to common pleas courts and the Medina County Adult Probation Department for drug testing.

### **Mental Health First Aid**

- Funding to the Medina County Health Department to provide Mental Health First Aid training to community members.

### **National Alliance on Mental Illness (NAMI) Medina County**

- Funding provided through Alternative Paths to participate in education, support and advocacy for those living with serious mental illness and their families.

### **Recovery Support Systems Ad Hoc Committee**

- Formed by the MHRB to identify and evaluate current recovery support systems in Medina County and make recommendations for ways to increase access and potentially expand and sustain those services.

### **State Recovery Conference**

- Funding registrations for local providers and individuals in recovery.

### **Suicide Prevention Coalition**

- Funding for operation of this committee.
- Sponsorship of the annual suicide prevention walk.
- Development and implementation of a LOSS (Local Outreach to Suicide Survivor) Team in Medina County.

### **Youth Resiliency & Counseling Center (YRCC)**

- The MHRB's newest initiative, which is a collaboration with OhioGuidestone.
- MHRB owned building.

## **SENIORS**

### **Medina County Senior & Adult Services**

- Funding for senior prevention services in Brunswick, Medina, Wadsworth, and Lodi.

### **Catholic Charities Community Services- Medina County**

- Home-based case management for seniors.
- Healthy IDEAS – Evidence-based programming for seniors.

## **HOUSING**

### **Cathy's House**

- MHRB support for Medina level 2-recovery housing for up to 17 men.
- MHRB support for Medina level 1- recovery housing for up to 6 men.
- MHRB support for Brunswick level 2-recovery housing for up to 5 men.
- MHRB support for Medina Farm House level 2-recovery housing for up to 12 men.

### **Discovery Recovery House (DRH)**

- A 12-bed, level 3 women's recovery house owned by the MHRB and operated by OhioGuidestone. DRH currently serves women and may be able to serve women and their children in the future.
- OhioGuidestone offers treatment, peer and recovery support services for residents.

### **Manhattan and Jefferson Apartments**

- Housing units purchased by the Medina County MHRB for long-term housing.

### **Medina Metropolitan Housing Authority (MMHA)**

- Contract with MMHA to manage MHRB properties, including ones for those with serious mental health issues, and to provide HUD/Housing consultation services.

- Provided funding to support a case management position to assist with the homeless population.

### **Northland Place I and II**

- Housing units owned and operated by the Medina MHRB with programming through Alternative Paths.

### **Washington Apartments**

- Housing units owned and operated by the Medina MHRB with programming through Alternative Paths.
